Dear Ms. Dortch:

Olvie E. Sisk, licensee of Station WCNA(FM), Potts Camp, Mississippi, previously submitted a petition for rule making requesting the reallocation and change of community of license of WCNA(FM), Channel 240C3, from Potts Camp to Saltillo, Mississippi. The Commission considered that petition in the above-referenced docket, denied the petition for rule making, and also denied Mr. Sisk's application for review. *Potts Camp and Saltillo, Mississippi*, FCC 01-241, released August 29, 2001. Thereafter, Mr. Sisk timely filed a Petition for Review of this decision with the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit, and that petition remains pending, Case No. 01-1514.

Recently, however, Mr. Sisk noted that the technical information with regard to his Saltillo proposal appears to have been removed from the Commission's technical database. Since the denial of the proposed reallocation has not yet become final due to the pending appeal, however, that action was premature. Accordingly, Mr. Sisk requests that the technical information concerning his Saltillo proposal be restored to the database.
