

**ORDER**

The testimonial phase of this case terminated on September 26, 2002.

There will be a post hearing admissions session **on October 16, 2002, at 9:00 a.m.** to receive additional documentary matter from Peninsula Communications, Inc. ("PCI") relating to Enforcement Bureau exhibits which include partial copies of documents.<sup>1</sup> Cf. FRE 106 (remainder of or related writings or recorded statements).

The parties are also to submit at that time a Stipulation that will substitute for EB Exh. 23 that was removed from the record, with leave from the Presiding Judge, in order to afford protection to financial information.


