Re: Applications for Consent to the Transfer of Control of Licenses from Comcast Corporation and AT&T Corp., Transferors, to AT&T Comcast Corporation, Transferee, MB Docket No. 02-70

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 15, 2002, Betsy Brady, Federal Government Affairs Vice President, AT&T Corp. ("AT&T"), Douglas Garrett, Vice President Law, AT&T Broadband, and the undersigned, outside counsel for AT&T, had a telephone conversation with W. Kenneth Ferree, Royce Sherlock, and Roger Holberg, of the Commission's Media Bureau, and Jim Bird, Karen Onyeije, and Nandan Joshi, of the Commission's Office of General Counsel. During the conversation, the AT&T representatives discussed AT&T 3, which is a local origination service wholly owned by AT&T Broadband. The AT&T representatives pointed out that AT&T 3 consists of a mix of local programming and syndicated programming that is selected and packaged by AT&T's Boston area systems for use by those systems, and that the programming on AT&T 3 is under the exclusive editorial control of those systems. The AT&T representatives further pointed out that AT&T 3 is primarily an opportunity to strengthen the brand identity of AT&T's Boston area systems and to market other services provided by those systems. The AT&T representatives also stated that no other distributor has made a request to distribute the service, thus AT&T 3 is not sold to any other distributor. Finally, the AT&T representatives said that they would provide further information to the Commission regarding AT&T 3 and other similar local origination services.
