Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of United States Cellular Corporation ("USCC") and its various subsidiaries and affiliates providing digital CMRS services, we hereby submit this notification that USCC has fully implemented TTY compatibility pursuant to the requirements set forth in the *Fourth Report and Order*¹.

On June 20, 2002 USCC filed a Petition for Temporary Waiver and Extension of Time ("Waiver Request") which requested a temporary and limited rule waiver of Section 20.18(c) of the FCC's Rules and an extension of time until September 30, 2002 to meet the June 30, 2002 deadline for digital wireless systems to be capable of transmitting calls from TTY devices. This request indicated that USCC would be TTY compliant at 44 of the 50 switches it operates by June 30, 2002, and sought an extension of time to become TTY compliant at the remaining five switches by September 30, 2002². The FCC did not act on USCC's timely filed Petition.

² USCC was TTY compliant at 44 of its 50 switches by June 30, 2002. Of the six remaining switches one was "analog" in nature and thus required no TTY upgrade, thus the remaining five switches were the focus of the June 20, 2002 Waiver Request.

However, in any case, USCC has now implemented TTY compatibility at its remaining five switches and is now fully TTY compliant in all of its market areas.
