Re: Applications for Consent to the Transfer of Control of Licenses from Comcast Corporation and AT&T Corp., Transferors, to AT&T Comcast Corporation, Transferee, MB Docket No. 02-70

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 19 and 27, 2002, AT&T Corp. ("AT&T") and Comcast Corporation ("Comcast") (collectively, the "Applicants") filed *ex parte* letters providing information regarding the status of pending franchise transfer of control applications before local franchising authorities ("LFAs") in connection with the above-referenced merger proceeding. As the Applicants indicated in those letters, they have sought approval for license transfers in connection with the proposed merger from a total of 1,791 LFAs. As of the date of this letter, 98.6% of the franchising authorities have either consented to the transfers or allowed the 120 day review period to elapse without objection. In the case of Comcast, 99.7% of its 660 local franchising authorities have consented or not objected to the transfer; in the case of AT&T Broadband, 97.97% of its 1,131 franchising authorities have consented or not objected to the transfer. AT&T and Comcast are of course working diligently to obtain the remaining local license transfers.
