On October 24, 2002, the Cellular Telecommunications & Internet Association (CTIA) represented by Diane Cornell, Vice President for Regulatory Policy, Andrea Williams, Assistant General Counsel, and Ron Barnes, Director for External and Industry Relations, met with Barry Ohlson, Joel Taubenblatt, Andra Cunningham, Patrick Forster, Joseph Levin, and Mindy Littell of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and Jerry Stanshine of the Office of Engineering and Technology.
