FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

Marathon Media Group, L.L.C. ("Marathon"), licensee of Station KHUL(FM) (formerly KONY-FM), Kanab, Utah, joined by Cameron Broadcasting, Inc. ("Cameron"), rule making proponent (together "Joint Parties"), by their respective counsel, hereby submit a further supplement in the above-captioned proceeding. See *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, 16 FCC Rcd 12722 (2001). The purpose of this supplement is to suggest an alternate channel to remove a conflict with MM Docket No. 02-124 (Amboy, California) which was pointed out in Marathon's recent filing in that proceeding

1. On July 15, 2002, Cameron filed a counterproposal in MM Docket No. 02-124, proposing, among other allotments, the relocation of Channel 234C from Kingman, Arizona to Pahrump, Nevada. On August 16, 2002, Marathon filed a Supplement in this proceeding pointing out that that Cameron's proposed allotment of Channel 234C at Pahrump conflicts with Marathon's proposed allotment of Channel 233A at Tecopa, California in this proceeding, and that Cameron's proposal was filed too late to be considered in the context of this proceeding.

2. Since that time, after discussions between the Joint Parties, it has been determined that an alternate channel is available to resolve the conflict. Specifically, Channel 250A can be

allotted to Tecopa, California as a substitute for Channel 291A instead of the originally proposed Channel 233A. Attached is an allocation study demonstrating the feasibility of the alternate channel allotment


3. Accordingly, the Joint Parties urge the Commission to allot Channel 250A to Tecopa, California. Channel 291A at Tecopa is currently vacant. The public interest would be furthered by substituting Channel 250A at Tecopa, thereby removing a conflict between this proceeding and MB Docket No. 02-124 and allowing Cameron's counterproposal there to be processed.




