

Cimarron, New Mexico has: at least three churches (Catholic, United Methodist, and Baptist). the International Bank, Cimarron Elementary and High Schools are adjacent to each other, Kiwanis Club, several service stations and food marts, a medical clinic, at least one hotel (historic St James Hotel), campgrounds, RV parks, Woody Crumbo Gallery and Indian Art Museum, and numerous other business. Philmont Scout Ranch (a national camp and training center of the Boy Scouts of America) borders the community on the south and west. The routes that I looked at were along US Highway 64 and the road to Philmont Scout Ranch. There was a lot of the village to the north of US Highway 64 that I could see, but I did not do a close look at, I did see a water town on the south slope of the mountain to the north of Cimarron.
