




Dear Mr. Crawford:

This is in response to the petition for rule making you filed on August 17, 2001, requesting the allotment of Channel 272C3 at Lewiston, Michigan, as the community's first local aural transmission.

We have reviewed the proposal and find that it is unacceptable for consideration at this time. A staff engineering analysis indicates that the site which you specify in your proposal (44-46-06 NL and 84-21-21 WL) is short-spaced to a prior-filed counterproposal in MM Docket No. 01-155. See 16 FCC Rcd 11103 (2001). Since your proposal was filed after July 16, 2001, it cannot be considered as a counterproposal in that proceeding.

For the reasons stated above, we are returning your petition for rule making. You may refile your petition, provided that your proposal meets all of the minimum spacing requirements of Section 73.207 of the Commission's Rules.
