On Wednesday, November 20, 2002, David Otten, Chairman & CEO of Celsat America, Inc. ("Celsat"), together with John Quale and the undersigned of this firm, met with Bryan Tramont, Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman Powell. At the meeting, Celsat discussed the characteristics of satellite phones needed to ensure that the ancillary terrestrial component (ATC) satisfies the Commission's definition of "ancillary" set forth in the *Flexible Use NPRM*.
