COUNTERPROPOSAL

Simmons-SLC, LS, LLC ("Siminons"). licensee of KJQN(FM), Brigham City, Utah, by its counsel, submits this counterproposal in the above-captioned proceeding.' Simmons requests that the Commission amend the FM Table of Allotments to delete Channel 264C at Brigham City, Utah, allot Channel 264C at Woodruff, Utah as that community's first local service, and modify the license of KJQN accordingly. To effectuate this reallocation, further changes will be necessary as described herein.

**I. PRELIMINARY MATTERS**

I. The effectuation of this Counterproposal requires a channel change for Station KBYI, Rcxburg, Idaho. Simmons has not secured the consent of the licensee of KBYI, Brigham Young University-Idaho, to the change, and request that the Commission issue an *Order to Show Cause* to the licensee for the channel change. Simmons pledges to reimburse the licensee for the costs of the channel change in accordance with *Circleville, Ohio*, 8 FCC 2d 159 (1967). In the meantime, Simmons has entered into discussions with the licensee regarding the change. If and

when an agreement is reached, Simmons will supplement the Counterproposal with the consent of the licensee. Nevertheless, this complies with the Commission's policy in *Columbus, Nebraska*, 50 RR 2d 1185 (1986) (permitting two involuntary changes)

2. If the Counterproposal is granted, Simmons will file an application to modify the facilities of KJQN to specify operation on Channel 264C at Woodruff.

3. The following table summarizes the changes requested in this Counterproposal (listed alphabetically):

**II. CONFLICT WITH THE NPRM**

4. As indicated in the attached Engineering Statement, Exhibit E, Figure 1, this proposal, which would result in the allotment of Channel 264C to Woodruff, Utah, conflicts with the NPRM proposal to allot Channel 263A to Opal, Wyoming. However, this Counterproposal would clearly be favored over the Opal proposal under the Commission's allotment priorities, since this Counterproposal offers a first local service to Woodruff, Utah, with a population of 194 (2000 U.S. Census), and new radio service to nearly one million additional people. By contrast, the Opal proposal offers a first local service to a smaller community of 104. See *Revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures*, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1982).

111. **COMPLIANCE WITH THE COMMISSION'S RULES**

A. **STATION KJQN, BRIGHAM CITY, UTAH TO WOODRUFF, UTAH**

1. **Technical Compliance**

5. In order to allot Channel 264C1 to Idaho Falls, as described above, Simmons proposes to relocate KJQN from Brigham City to Woodruff, Utah as that community's first local service. Channel 264C can be allotted to Woodruff in compliance with the Commission's spacing rules provided changes are made at Price, Utah and Reliance, Utah as described below. See Exhibit E, Figure 1. A 70 dBu signal can be provided to Woodruff from the proposed reference point. See Figure 2. The relocation will result in net increase in population of 930,531 persons able to receive service from the station. See Figure 3. The loss area will remain adequately served. See Figure 4. Portions of the loss area will have three or four local services after the relocation, and a very small area will be left with two local services. However, the services remaining in the loss area are comparable to those of other relocations recently granted by the Commission. In *Scappoose and Tillamook, Oregon*, 15 FCC Rcd 10899 (2000), the Commission granted a reallocation from Tillamook to Scappoose even though it left 4,312 persons with four aural services, 2,461 persons with three aural services, and 19 persons with two aural services. In *Detroit Lakes and Barnesville, Minnesota*, 16 FCC Rcd 22581 (2001), the Commission granted a reallocation from Detroit Lakes to Barnesville even though it left 1,458 persons with four aural services, 449 persons with three aural services, and 54 persons with two aural services. Other reallocation cases have left substantial populations with only four aural services. See, e.g., *Earle, Arkansas, et al.*, 10 FCC Rcd 8270 (1995) (7,026 persons with 4 aural services). While leaving people with fewer than five aural services may not be desirable, it is merely a factor to be considered under priority (4). In this case, the overall gains of the

Counterproposal, including advancing priority (3) and providing new service to approximately a million persons, militate in favor of its grant.

6. In addition, Figure 1 discloses that Channel 264C1 at Woodruff is mutually exclusive with the proposal set forth in the *NPRM* to allot Channel 263A to Opal, Wyoming as that community's first local service. However, this Counterproposal is preferred over the Opal proposal under the Commission's allotment priorities. Since both proposals would further priority 3 (first local service), the tiebreaker is the community of license population. *See e.g., Rose Hill, Trenton. Aurora and Ocracoke, North Carolina, 11 FCC Rcd 21223 (1996); Athens and Atlanta, Illinois 11 FCC Rcd 3445 (1996); and Blanchard, Louisiana and Stephens. Arkansas, 8 FCC Rcd 7083 (1993).* In this case, although the absolute population difference is small, Woodruff, with a 2000 population of 194, is nearly twice the size of Opal, with a 2000 population of 102.

7. Simmons, the licensee of KJQN, reiterates that it will apply for Channel 264C at Idaho Falls, and construct the facility if its application is granted.

## 2. Change in Community of License

8. In *Amendment of the Commission's Rules Regarding Modification of FM and TV Authorizations to Specify a New Community of License, 4 FCC Rcd 4870 (1989), recon. granted in part, 5 FCC Rcd 7094 (1990) ("Community of License")*, the Commission stated that in order to grant a change in community of license: (1) the proposed use of the channel must be mutually exclusive with its current use; (2) the existing community of license must retain local service; and (3) the proposed arrangement of allotments must be preferred over the existing arrangement under the Commission's allotment priorities. The proposed change in community of license from Brigham City to Woodruff satisfies these prerequisites. First, the proposed use of Channel

264C at Woodruff is mutually exclusive with its current use at Brigham City. *See* Figure 1. **Second**, Brigham City will not be deprived of local service since Stations **KRAR(FM)**, **KSOS(AM)**, and **KXOL(AM)** will remain licensed to Brigham City. Third, the proposed arrangement of allotments is preferred since a first local service at Woodruff (**pop.** 194) under priority 3 is preferred over a fourth local service at Brigham City (pop. 17,411) under priority 4. *See Revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, supra.*

9. Woodruff is located outside any **urbanized** area, and the proposed signal will not cover more than 50 percent of any urbanized area. Therefore, this relocation does not implicate the Commission's policy concerning the potential migration of stations from underserved rural areas to well-served urban areas. *See Headland, Alabama and Chattahoochee, Florida*, 10 FCC Rcd 10352 (1995).

10. The Town of Woodruff, Utah, is a community deserving of a first local service. The Commission previously held that Woodruff was a community for allotment purposes, but denied the allotment for other reasons. *Fort Bridger, Wyoming and Woodruff, Utah*, 17 FCC Rcd 606 (2002). Woodruff is a rural community located in Rich County. Woodruff is listed in the U.S. Census 2000 with a population of 194, and is not located within any urbanized area. The U.S. Post Office associates ZIP Code 84086 with Woodruff and operates the Woodruff Main Post Office at 40 South Main Street. Woodruff's government functions independently of any other governmental units and is composed of a mayor and town council. Woodruff also has its own local fire department offering fire, rescue, EMS and other services to area residents. Woodruff has several local businesses. Woodruff is home to a Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, which has a congregation of approximately 500 members. Among the events that are

held in Woodruff are the Annual Parade and Rodeo each Fourth of July. Woodruff is a host for Race Across America, an internationally known cross-country bicycle race. See Exhibit B.

**B. VACANT CHANNEL 265C3, RELIANCE, WYOMING**

11. In order to allot Channel 264C to Woodruff, Utah, Channel 265C3 must be deleted at Reliance, Wyoming. Simmons proposes to substitute Channel 254C3 for Channel 265C3 at Reliance. Channel 254C3 can be allotted to Reliance at the current allotment reference point in compliance with the Commission's spacing rules. See Figure 9.

**C. STATION KWSA, PRICE, UTAH**

12. In order to allot Channel 264C to Woodruff, Utah, Channel 265C2 must be deleted at Price, Utah. Simmons proposes to substitute Channel 261A for Channel 265C2 at Price, Utah. Station KWSA currently is licensed on Channel 265A at Price, with a construction permit to upgrade to Channel 265C2. Channel 261A can be allotted at the KWSA licensed transmitter coordinates, provided a small change is made in the allotment reference coordinates for the vacant Channel 260A allotment at Fountain Green, Utah. See Figure 5. The gain/loss study shows a theoretical loss area from the reallocation, but since Channel 265C2 is an unbuilt facility, there will not be any actual loss of service. See Figure 6.

13. Simmons has entered into an agreement with the licensee of KWSA to secure its consent to the channel change and downgrade in exchange for compensation. The licensee's consent is attached hereto. See Exhibit A. Simmons hereby restates that it will reimburse the licensee of Station KWSA in accordance with the guidelines set forth in *Circleville, Ohio*, 8 FCC 2d 159 (1967).

14. With respect to the Fountain Green allotment, Channel 260A can be allotted to Fountain Green, Utah at slightly different allotment reference coordinates (the change is only


approximately 100 meters). *See* Figure 7. The 70 dBu contour completely encloses the community of Fountain Green. *See* Figure 8. The Commission can order an allotment reference point change in the context of a proceeding to amend the Table of Allotments. *See Cross Plains, Texas et al.*, 15 FCC Rcd 5506 at ¶ 12 (2000).

#### IV. CONCLUSION

Grant of the Counterproposal is in the public interest because Woodruff, Utah will receive a first local service and an additional population of nearly one million people will receive radio service. Simmons is confident that the changes can be implemented smoothly and rapidly. Accordingly, the Commission should grant the Counterproposal

**General**

We have been retained by Simmons-SLC, LS, LLC (herein referred to as "Simmons-SLC") to prepare the engineering portion of a counterproposal to MB Docket 02-294 (RM-10543). The original petition for rule making seeks to allot channel 263A to Opal, Wyoming as that community's first commercial FM radio service. Simmons-SLC, in the instant counterproposal, seeks to file a counterproposal to this petition for rule making. The instant counterproposal will provide a first local service to Woodruff, Utah.

**Exhibits Explained**

Channel 264C, Woodruff, Utah

Exhibit E, Figure 1 is an allocation study showing the spacings to other stations if channel 264C is reallocated from Brigham City, Utah to Woodruff, Utah as that community's first local aural service. The only short spacings shown are to KWSA, channel 265C2 in Price, Utah; and a vacant allotment for channel 265C3 at Reliance, Wyoming; and the proposed allotment of channel 263A at Opal, Wyoming. This is the MX point with the PKM.

Exhibit E, Figure 2 shows the proposed city-grade contour for channel 264C from the proposed site. The city-grade contour covers 100% of Woodruff, Utah. Exhibit E,

Figure 3 is a gain/loss study that demonstrates the proposed areas that channel 264C will cover and will no longer cover as a result of the proposed relocation. Exhibit E, Figure 4

show that no gray or white area is created with the move of KJQN from Briyham City to Woodruff.

#### Channel 261A. Price, Utah

In order to allocate channel 264C at Woodruff, the short spacing with channel 265C2 (KWSA) in Price, Utah must be eliminated. (KWSA has a construction permit for channel 265C2, although it is currently operating on channel 265A.) In order to alleviate this short spacing, it is proposed to delete channel 265C2 at Price and allocate channel 261A at Price. Exhibit E, Figure 5 is an allocation study showing the proposed short spacing to only one other facility. Exhibit E, Figure 6 shows the area lost by the proposed modification to KWSA.

#### Channel 260A. Fountain Green, Utah

KWSA's substitution of channel 261A at Price, Utah creates short spacing to a vacant allotment of channel 260A at Fountain Green, Utah. The instant counterproposal seeks to modify the allocation coordinates of channel 260A at Fountain Green by 0.10 kilometer, which leaves the allocation coordinates still inside the community of Fountain Green. Exhibit E, Figure 7 shows that this modification requires no other spectrum modifications. Exhibit E, Figure 8 shows that this modified allocation will continue to cover Fountain Green with a city-grade signal.

#### Channel 254C3, Reliance, Wyoming

In order to allocate channel 264C at Woodruff, Utah, the proposed short spacing with the vacant allotment at Reliance, Wyoming must be eliminated. Simmons-SLC proposes to substitute channel 254C3 at Reliance for channel 265C3 with no site change needed. (See Exhibit E, Figure Y.)

### **Conclusion**

The allocation of channel 264C at Woodruff, Utah in the instant counterproposal will offer that community a first local service. Woodruff (population 192) is larger than Opal, Wyoming (population 102) and hence, is preferred over the allotment of channel **263A** at **Opal** under priority (3).





Gain/Loss Study Map



Remaining Services Study Map



Gain/Loss Study Map




