Black Diamond Broadcasting, by its counsel, hereby submits its Comments in response to the Commission's Notice of Proposed Rule Making ("NPRM"), released September 27, 2002, DA 02-2320, proposing to amend the FM Table of Allotments by adding Channel 263A at Opal, Wyoming

1. The NPRM was released in response to Black Diamond's Petition for Rule Making ("Petition") proposing the allotment of Channel 263A to Opal. The new allotment will be the first local aural transmission service to Opal.

2. Black Diamond hereby states that if the Commission approves the requested allotment of Channel 263A Opal, Wyoming, Black Diamond will submit an application for a construction permit specifying a transmitter site which provides principal community coverage to Opal and, if its application is granted, construct the facility.
