Dear Ms. Dortch:

Qwest Communications International Inc. (“Qwest”) submits this filing at the request of Commission staff to respond to Eschelon's allegations that there are a significant number of errors with flow-through orders.

As described in Qwest's Reply Comments, the examples described by Eschelon are not indicative of systemic problems¹. Each of the examples provided was specifically addressed.

On a more comprehensive basis, Qwest provided a further breakdown of Order Accuracy via Call Center Data July-September results separating flow through and manually handled orders². Those results confirm that there are no significant issues with Qwest's flow-through orders (i.e., combined nine state results of 99.8% in July, 99.9% in August and 99.9% in September).


