On Friday, December 6, 2002, Dick Notebaert, Chairman and CEO of Qwest Communications International Inc. ("Qwest"), Gary Lytle, Senior Vice President, Federal Relations, and Melissa Newman, Vice President, Federal Regulatory, met with Commissioner Michael Copps and Jordan Goldstein to discuss Qwest's application to provide in-region InterLATA service in the nine states referenced above. In particular, Mr. Notebaert discussed the agreements it recently filed with its state commissions, loop qualification issues, and the status of its section 272 affiliate.

In addition, Mr. Notebaert reiterated Qwest's views in the Triennial Review proceeding, specifically that switching should no longer be an unbundled network element because it does not meet the "necessary and impair" test under the 1996 Telecommunications Act.
