

Pursuant to the requirements of Sections 1.1200 et seq. of the Commission's rules, you are hereby notified on behalf of XO Communications, Inc and XO California, Inc. that Gerry Salemme, XO Senior Vice President, and the undersigned left telephone messages yesterday for Christopher Libertelli, Legal Advisor to Chairman Michael Powell, Monica Desai, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Kevin Martin, Jordan Goldstein, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps and Matthew Brill, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Kathleen Abernathy. The voicemail messages stated that XO California, Inc. had accepted and executed on Friday, Dec. 6, 2002 a revised amendment offered by SBC Pacific setting an interim DS3 UNE loop rate of \$573.20 instead of the current rate of \$1,837.18. In addition, the revised amendment, which was presented to XO California on Dec. 6, also was offered by SBC Pacific with an effective date of Dec. 6, 2002 and with modified change of law language acceptable to XO.
