On December 11, 2002, Michael Capellas, Chief Executive Officer, WorldCom, Inc. ("WorldCom") and Donna Sorgi, Vice President, Federal Advocacy, WorldCom, met with Chairman Michael K. Powell, Commissioner Kathleen Q. Abernathy, Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein, Commissioner Michael J. Copps, Commissioner Kevin J. Martin, and their legal advisors, respectively, Christopher Libertelli, Matthew Brill, Eric Einhorn, Jordan Goldstein, and Daniel Gonzalez. In the course of those meetings, WorldCom discussed the importance of the unbundled network element platform (UNE-P) to competition for mass market customers, consistent with previous WorldCom submissions in the *UNE Triennial Review* proceeding.
