On December 17, 2002, the Cellular Telecommunications & Internet Association (CTIA) represented by Diane Cornell, Vice President for Regulatory Policy, Andrea Williams, Assistant General Counsel, and Ron Barnes, Director for External and Industry Relations, met with Commissioner Kathleen Q.
