

I fully support RM-10582 as submitted. While it is within the existing rules for someone to submit many applications for a desirable amateur radio vanity callsign (such as the 1x2 and 2x1 format), I believe that such actions violate the spirit of good amateur practice and fairness. Each amateur licensee who applies for a callsign on the day the callsign becomes available should have an equal chance with the other applicants. As a taxpayer, I am concerned about the expense the FCC incurs with having to issue refunds for the many dismissed applications resulting from an applicant who submits a large number of applications for a callsign in order to increase their odds of getting the callsign.
