Dear Ms. Dortch:

Conestoga Wireless Company ("Conestoga") hereby submits its final report on implementation of TTY access to 9-1-1 over its digital wireless network, pursuant to instructions set forth in the Commission's *Order* released June 28, 2002, in CC Docket No. 94-102.¹ Conestoga's digital wireless network uses GSM infrastructure equipment from Nortel Networks ("Nortel").

In June of this year, Conestoga was forced to file a request for limited waiver of the TTY implementation deadline because Nortel had only recently developed an acceptable TTY solution for its GSM customers, and because we did not have time to complete the installation and testing of the required software upgrades prior to June 30, 2002.² We amended our waiver request after we encountered technical problems during the software upgrade process.³


