**ORDER**

By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. This Order dismisses the Request for Review filed by Wayne County Public School (Wayne County), Goldsboro, North Carolina.<sup>1</sup> Wayne County seeks review of a decision issued by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator) on July 8, 2002.<sup>2</sup> The Commission received Wayne County's Request for Review on September 24, 2002.<sup>3</sup>

2. For requests seeking review of decisions issued on or after August 13, 2001 under section 54.720(b) of the Commission's rules, any such appeal must be filed with the Commission or SLD within 60 days of the issuance of the decision that the party seeks to have reviewed.<sup>4</sup>


