

Telephone solicitation is an unwarranted intrusion into the homes of the citizens of this country. But the part of this practice that is most offensive is the use of electronic dialing equipment which results in many persons answering their telephones and receiving no response. Often this procedure is repeated within a very short time period. If the ordinary citizen cannot be protected against the incursions of the telephone solicitor, at least the practice of the random electronic dialing procedure should be prohibited.
