NOTICE WITH RESPECT TO EMERGENCY PETITION FOR DECLARATORY RULING REGARDING ILEC OBLIGATIONS TO CONTINUE PROVIDING SERVICES

Winstar Communications, LLC (“IDT Winstar”) hereby provides notice that it and Verizon Communications Inc. have settled their dispute with respect to IDT Winstar’s acquisition of the assets of Winstar Communications, Inc. (“Old Winstar”). **As** a result of that settlement, there is no relief with respect to that particular transaction for the Commission to grant with respect to Verizon in response to the Emergency Petition for Declaratory Ruling (the “Winstar Petition”) filed by IDT Winstar in the captioned proceeding. This notice shall only affect the relief sought against Verizon and shall not affect the relief sought against any other party in the Winstar Petition.


Verizon has also filed a Counter-Petition for Declaratory Ruling (the “Counter-Petition”), which will remain pending as to transactions other than IDT Winstar’s acquisition of the assets of Old Winstar. Verizon and IDT Winstar have agreed that the Commission, in order to reach its ruling on the Counter-Petition, may take into account all legal arguments made by Verizon and
