By the Acting Deputy Chief, Telecommunications Access Policy Division:

On December 13,2002, the Commission released a Report and Order and Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the above dockets (FCC 02-329) modifying the universal service contribution methodology and seeking comment on three alternative assessment systems. This erratum corrects the following errors:

Replace “Page” with “Paragraph” in the Table of Contents on page 2.

Replace the page numbers in the Table of Contents with the following paragraph numbers: 1, 7, 7, 9, 14, 19, 20, 20, 28, 40, 41, 64, 66, 75, 86, 96, 101,101, 122, 123,136, 137, 141, 142.

Replace text of footnote 143 with “*See AT&T Dec 4 Ex Parte* at 6 (asserting contractual arrangements may prohibit AT&T from recovering universal service contributions through pass through charges).”

Replace item 119 of FCC Form 499-Q on page 73 with “First Quarter 2003 (January 1 through March 31) projected gross-billed end-user interstate and international telecommunications revenues including any pass-through charges for universal service contributions, but excluding international-to-international revenues”.

Delete “TO INDIVIDUALS” from the first complete paragraph in the Instructions on page 74.

Delete “the Privacy Act of 1974, P.L. 93-579, December 31, 1974, 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(e)(3), and” from the second complete paragraph in the Instructions on page 75
