Numbering Resource Optimization and Local Number Portability***

Dear Mr. Caton:

Pursuant to Sections 1.1206(b)(1) of the Commission's Rules, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and the People of the State of California submit for filing this notice of a recent ex parte communication with FCC commissioners. The ex parte communication was in the form of a letter from CPUC Commissioners Loretta Lynch and Carl Wood to all five FCC Commissioners.

The letter addresses the CPUC Commissioners' concerns about the possibility that the FCC may allow wireless carriers to deploy local number portability (LNP) only pursuant to receipt of a bona fide request (BFR) from another carrier. The CPUC letter urges the FCC to eliminate the BFR requirement in the interests of consumer protection and furthering competition. A copy of the letter is included in this filing.
