On Thursday, January 30, 2003, K. Rupert Murdoch, Mike Regan, and Maureen O'Connell of News Corporation met with Commissioner Michael Copps and his legal advisors Alexis Johns and Paul Margie. During the meeting, Mr. Murdoch, Mr. Regan and Ms. O'Connell urged the Commission to eliminate or modify all of its existing media ownership restrictions in a manner consistent with the views of Fox Entertainment Group, Inc. and Fox Television Stations, Inc. as set forth in its comments (filed jointly with NBC/Telemundo and Viacom on January 2, 2003) in the above-captioned proceedings.
