THIRD STATUS REPORT

1. The Enforcement Bureau, pursuant to the Order released in this proceeding on July 19, 2002 by Chief Administrative Law Judge Richard L. Sippel, hereby files this status report

2. According to Assistant United States Attorney Shawn Chen, defense counsel for Dr. Liebermann filed a motion for a continuance in the criminal proceeding currently before the United States District Court for the State of Connecticut, Criminal No. 3:02CR55 (EBB). The motion was granted, and the case continued until June of this year.

3. Further, on September 17, 2002, the Federal Communications Commission was sent a request for documents under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, by criminal defense counsel representing Dr. Raanan Liebermann in the aforementioned criminal proceeding. By letter dated October 4, the Enforcement Bureau informed defense counsel of the estimated costs to process their FOIA request. On October 14, defense counsel requested that




