On February 11, 2003, I had a telephone conversation with Mr. Christopher Libertelli, Legal Advisor to Chairman Powell, concerning the above-referenced proceedings. During the discussion, EarthLink reiterated points previously submitted in the above-referenced dockets regarding the importance of preserving line sharing as an unbundled network element (UNE). EarthLink explained that it relies on Covad, a CLEC, for much of its DSL provisioning, and that line sharing is an important competitive option for broadband DSL.
