
On behalf of Qwest Communications International Inc. (“Qwest”), this letter and its attachments are being provided at the request of the Wireline Competition Bureau. This letter provides two attachments related to the Cricket PCS survey in New Mexico that present the results of the participants’ responses to each question included in the survey. Each attachment is two pages in length. The first of these attachments provides results in percentages and the second attachment provides results in numbers of participants. The first page of the first attachment that provides the percentages was introduced in the New Mexico state proceedings by Qwest and is included in the state record filed at the FCC with Qwest’s application (*see* Appendix K, Vol. 1, Tab 1274). However, each of the attached two-page documents was provided in full in discovery to all parties in the New Mexico state proceeding.

The survey questions were previously provided to the Commission in Exhibit DLT-Track A/PI-NM-5 attached to the January 15, 2003 Declaration of David L. Teitzel (“Teitzel Declaration”) filed in this proceeding. The results of the responses to the key survey questions are discussed in Exhibits DLT-Track A/PI-NM-5 (April 16, 2002 Direct Testimony of Keith Frederick) and DLT-Track A/PI-NM-6 (June 5, 2002 Rebuttal Testimony of Keith Frederick) which are exhibits attached to the Teitzel Declaration filed in this proceeding. The survey results are also discussed in paragraphs 43 through 45 of the Teitzel Declaration. The two attachments to this letter provide the responses to the survey questions in an easy to review document.
