The parties met to discuss the status of Cingular's pending Petition for Declaratory Ruling (filed on April 23, 2002) that seeks to preempt recent amendments to an Anne Arundel County ("County") zoning ordinance.¹ Cingular and Sprint reiterated the need for prompt action
