

This is to advise you that, on November 7, 2002, the Consumer Federation of America, Consumers Union and Center for Digital Democracy filed a joint Petition for Review, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 402(a), of the following order: *In the Matter of Applications for Consent to the Transfer of Control of Licenses From Comcast Corporation and AT&T Corp., Transferors, to AT&T Comcast Corporation, Transferee*, MB Docket No. 02-70, FCC 02-301 (released November 6, 2002).

Petitioners challenge the FCC's decision not to release to them a document contained in DOJ Hart-Scott-Rodino filings pertinent to the merger between AT&T and Comcast.

The Court has docketed this case as No. 02-1337. The attorney assigned to handle the litigation of this case is Joel Marcus.
