Wireless Telecommunications Bureau Extends Deadline for Filing Comments and Reply Comments on the Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in CC Docket No. 94-102, IB Docket No. 99-67, FCC 02-326

By this Public Notice, the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (Bureau) extends the time for filing comments and reply comments on its Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking concerning possible revisions to its enhanced 911 rules.<sup>1</sup> The time for filing comments is changed from February 3, 2003, to February 18, 2003. The time for filing reply comments is changed from February 28, 2003, to March 11, 2003.

On December 20, 2002, the Commission released its Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the above captioned dockets. Because of delays in getting the item noticed in the Federal Register, pursuant to Commission rule 1.4(b)(1), the Bureau takes this action on its own motion to extend the deadline to ensure all commenters are given adequate notice and time to prepare comments in this proceeding.
