Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 7, 2003, the undersigned counsel for ABS-CBN Telecom North America, Inc. ("ABS-CBN"), met with Jennifer Manner, Senior Counsel to Commissioner Kathleen Abernathy, to review the position taken by ABS-CBN in its February 27 Reply Comments. Counsel also provided Ms. Manner a copy of the appended market share data for U.S. and Philippine carriers that had previously been provided to the International Bureau in connection with ABS-CBN Telecom's March 4, 2003 ex parte meeting with Claudia Fox, Deputy Chief, International Bureau, Policy Division. In addition to the arguments stated in the ABS-CBN Telecom Reply, counsel urged the Commission to independently verify the factual assertion regarding any allegation of blocked circuits. Counsel stated that legal precedent for injunctive relief requires that any stop payment order be limited to those Philippine carriers which have actually disrupted a U.S. carrier's traffic and possess market power.
