



PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Charles Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 250A at George West, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 250A to George West, Texas as that community's first local FM service. George West currently does not have a licensed facility. There are currently three allocations to George West which will be available for auction at some date in the future. George West is an incorporated city with a population of 2,524 people and 160 businesses that have been given a credit rating by Dun & Bradstreet as of the last quarter of 2000 according to the Texas Almanac 2002-2003. George West has its own mayor, August Caron, Jr., its own school system, the George West Independent School District, its own post office, its own volunteer fire department, its own police department, its own city hall, chamber of commerce and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 250A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to George West residents and therefore is in the public interest.


