
**Re: Notification of Ex Parte Communication in ET Docket 98-206; RM-9147;

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 10, 2003, Antoinette Cook Bush of Northpoint Technology, Ltd. ("Northpoint") met with the following Commission officials: Bruce Franca, Geraldine Maise, Ira Keltz, and Tom Derenge of the Office of Engineering and Technology; and Shellie Blakeney, Ramona Melson, Margaret Wiener and Brian Carter of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss various technical issues in connection with the pending petitions for reconsideration in ET Docket 98-206. The three attached handouts (each of which has been filed previously in this docket) were distributed at the meeting and summarize the points covered. Ms. Bush noted that unless the Commission's EIRP limit is raised or eliminated, Northpoint would be forced to apply for several thousand waivers in order to build out a nationwide MVDDS system.
