Response to Staff's Information Request of March 7, 2003

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Global Crossing Ltd. and GC Acquisition Limited (together, "Applicants") submit this letter at the request of the staff of the International Bureau ("IB"). During a telephone call with Applicants' counsel on March 7, 2003, the IB's staff requested: (i) confirmation that Cheung Kong (Holdings) Limited ("CKHL") continues to hold a total beneficial interest in Hutchison Whampoa Ltd. ("HWL") of 49.97%; (ii) confirmation of the percentage of the shares of HWL held directly by CKHL and its subsidiaries and the percentage held through nominees; and (iii) the percentage of HWL's shares held by each known nominee shareholder.¹ The IB requested that Applicants respond to these requests using a record date of January 28, 2003, which is the record date that Applicants' have used in previous filings.²

In response to the IB's requests, Hutchison Telecommunications Limited has provided the information below to Applicants.

1. As of January 28, 2003, CKHL's total beneficial interest in HWL was 49.97%.

2. As of January 28, 2003, 26.92% of HWL's shares were held directly by wholly-owned subsidiaries of CKHL. CKHL's remaining interest in HWL (representing 23.05% of HWL's shares) was held entirely through HSBC Nominees (Hong Kong) Limited ("HSBC").
3. As of January 28, 2003, 40.55% of HWL's shares were held directly by HSBC, 26.16% of HWL's shares were held directly by HKSCC Nominees Limited ("HKSCC"), and, as reported above, 26.92% of HWL's shares were held directly by wholly-owned subsidiaries of CKHL.³ The remaining 6.37% of HWL's shares were held directly by approximately 16,600 entities, each of which held directly less than 0.7% of HWL's shares. HWL does not know which (if any) of these entities held HWL's shares as nominees for other entities.

Applicants have been advised that no material changes to the above information have occurred since January 28, 2003.


