During these meetings we discussed the issues raised in AT&T's Petition for Reconsideration and Clarification filed in the above-referenced proceedings. In addition to the issues raised in that petition, AT&T also discussed the need for clarification that interexchange carrier Lifeline revenues be exempt from the universal service fund revenue base.
