Dear Ms. Dortch:

Cypress Communications, Inc. ("Cypress Communications") hereby notifies the Commission, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 64.1120(e), of the impending transfer of the California customer base and certain related assets of the shared tenant services business of Eureka Broadband Corporation ("Eureka Broadband") to Cypress Communications and its operating subsidiary, Cypress Communications Operating Company, Inc. ("Cypress Operating"), pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement entered into by and among Cypress Communications and Eureka Broadband, the parent company of Gillette Global Networks, Inc. ("GGN"). The interstate and international telecommunications services being provided by GGN at the Eureka Broadband STS and other locations to the customers that are being transferred include dedicated and non-dedicated, toll free, calling card, and data communications services.¹ Following the transfer, Cypress Operating will provide interstate and international telecommunications services (as well as the intrastate services) to the affected customers. The transfer of the customer base will occur as soon as the FCC's and California's regulatory requirements are met.

Cypress Communications, Inc. is incorporated in Delaware. GGN is a subsidiary of Eureka Broadband Corporation and is incorporated in Delaware.

Attached is a copy of the form of the notice letter being sent to the affected subscriber base and a certification as required by 47 C.F.R. § 64.1120(e)(1). Please include this notice and the attachment in the record of the above-referenced proceeding.



Re: Change of service provider: assignment of existing contracts

Dear Valued Customer:

Eureka Broadband Corporation ("Eureka") has recently entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement with Cypress Communications, Inc. ("Cypress Communications") to sell its Southern California operations. The decision was driven primarily by the desire to focus EurekaGGN's efforts on its core market in New York City. EurekaGGN greatly values and appreciates your business and as a result, spent considerable time and energy selecting a leading telecommunications service provider to serve your needs.

Beginning on or after March 31, 2003, Cypress Communications, and its affiliated telecommunications services provider, Cypress Communications Operating Company, Inc. ("Cypress Operating," and together with Cypress Communications, "Cypress"), will be providing the telecommunications and related services that are currently being provided to you by Eureka and its affiliated telecommunications services providers Eureka Telecom, LLC and Gillette Global Network, Inc. (together "EurekaGGN"). The following overview outlines how your services will be transitioned from EurekaGGN to Cypress. **There will be no interruption to your current telecommunications services.**

About Cypress Communications

Cypress is the leading provider of premium, in-building communications services to small and medium sized businesses located in multi-tenant office buildings and campuses throughout the United States. The company offers customized, fully integrated service packages that may include some combination of local, long distance, toll free services, calling cards, high speed internet connectivity, email services, fully managed firewall services, web hosting, virtual private networks, feature rich digital desktop stations, audio and web conferencing and digital business television. The local and long distance telecommunications services offered by the company are provided by Cypress Operating. Seamless Transfer of Services

As your new service provider, Cypress will continue to provide you with the same telecommunications services and other services you currently receive in accordance with the terms and conditions of your existing contract, and notice of future changes, if any, to those terms will be provided in accordance with your existing contracts and applicable law. Notice of this change in service providers has been filed with the Federal Communications Commission and California Public Utilities Commission, and will be virtually transparent to you because

Cypress will utilize similar, if not the same, facilities and support staff that currently serve your account. Please be assured that you will not incur any charges, including local telephone company carrier change charges, related to the transfer of your telephone account to Cypress Operating. However, any "freeze" that you have placed on your existing telephone lines to prevent unauthorized transfer to another long distance carrier will be over-ridden for purposes of this transaction, and will need to be reinstated by you after the transfer is complete.

Who to Contact with Questions

While Cypress hopes that you will choose to remain with it following the transfer and for many years to come, you do have the right to select another carrier for your services consistent with the terms of your existing contract. Any questions you may have regarding your current services can be addressed by calling the EurekaGGN customer service department using your current toll-free number (800-562-4206). You may also contact Cypress' customer service department to learn more about Cypress and its service offerings prior to the transfer by calling its toll-free number (866-711-3207). Any service orders or complaints you may have prior to the transfer should be addressed to EurekaGGN, while any service orders or complaints you may have during the transfer may be directed to Cypress.

Contracts, Billing and Payment

In connection with this change in service providers, your existing contract with EurekaGGN will be assigned to Cypress Communications. Effective on or after March 31, 2003, Cypress will assume all of the rights and responsibilities of EurekaGGN under your existing contract for services and your relationship with EurekaGGN under that contract will be transferred to Cypress. Cypress will provide additional information in the coming weeks relating to changes in billing addresses, technical support numbers, and other contract-related contact information. In the meantime, please continue to pay your invoices to EurekaGGN in the normal timely manner until further notice.

It has been the pleasure of EurekaGGN to provide you with quality local, long distance and data communications services and we emphasize that you are a valued customer and will be treated as such by Cypress, who looks forward to serving you and appreciates your business.
