Qwest Communications International Inc. ("Qwest") submits this filing to update the Commission on a matter discussed in a letter filed with the Enforcement Bureau in CC Docket No. 99-272 on March 7, 2003, a copy of which was submitted in the above-referenced docket on the same day. That letter discussed the findings of an internal Qwest review. Specifically, Qwest had identified six private line circuits reflected in its internal records that were shown as erroneously not divested at the time of the Qwest-U S WEST merger and as still connected. Qwest can report to you that the Teleglobe circuit was disconnected as of March 14, the four Triumph circuits were disconnected as of March 20, and our records are being or have been so corrected. Qwest has informed ELI that we intend to disconnect the sixth circuit, a DS3 used by ELI, on Monday, March 24. Qwest will advise the Commission when that has been done.

This ex parte is in response to questions from the Commission staff, and consequently does not implicate the 20 page limit on ex parte filings. Please contact me if you have any further questions.
