On March 21, 2003, Dan Moloney, President of Motorola's Broadband Communications Sector, and Carl McGrath, Corporate Vice President and General Manager, Digital Core Gateways, and I, accompanied by Richard Wiley of Wiley, Rein & Fielding, met with Commissioner Kevin Martin and Catherine Bohigian, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Martin on Media Issues.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss issues relating to the above-referenced proceeding. Mr. Moloney displayed the Motorola DCT2020 host terminal with POD slot and reviewed Motorola's research, development and manufacturing activities related to PODs. Messrs. Moloney and McGrath discussed Motorola's commitment to the sale at retail of set top equipment and to manufacturing PODs. We also discussed consumer cost impacts pertaining to the 2005 date ban on embedded security equipment and the necessary lead times for volume production of PODs.
