

I attended all of the meetings. Eduardo Peña, Esq., communications counsel for the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC), also attended the meeting with Commissioner Adelstein. At these meetings, we provided copies of the "Supplemental Comments of Diversity and Competition Supporters," filed January 27, 2003.

At each of these meetings, we underscored the importance of addressing minority ownership in the proceeding. To build a full record on this issue, we urged the Commission to convene a public hearing on minority ownership to mark the occasion of the 25th anniversary of the Statement of Policy on Minority Ownership of Broadcast Facilities, 68 FCC2d 979 (released May 25, 1978). We also explained the "Staged Implementation Plan", full details of which are found in the "Initial Comments of Diversity and Competition Supporters" ("Initial Comments") filed January 2, 2003, pp. 82-101.

In the meetings with Mr. Ferree, Commissioner Adelstein, and Ms. Mago, we also explained the "equal transactional opportunity" policy described on pp. 115-120 of the Initial Comments and the FM allotments plan described on pp. 128-141 of the Initial Comments.
