To Whom it May Concern,

Brevard County School District is appealing the decision by the Universal Service Administrative Company, Schools & Libraries Division regarding a Service Extension Request. This denial resulted in the non-payment of a final draw for the sum of \$157,305.40 to Universal Cabling Systems, Inc. who performed an E-Rate retrofit cabling project for Brevard County Schools. (ref #1)

On September 4, 2001, Brevard County School District received a funding commitment letter (Ref.#2) from USAC for the following project:

The retrofit-cabling project that was funded for Brevard County was approved to provide fiber and enhanced Cat 6 wiring to each classroom with direct connection back to the district firewall connection. This project will allow students to access the Internet and district distance learning facilities at each of the five eligible school sites.

Due to the complexity of the retrofit project, additional time ~~was~~ required for completion. On May 8, 2002, following the advise from the Schools & Libraries Division (Ref. #4) and the Florida Department of Education E-Rate Director a Contract Extension; Form 500 (Ref.#5) was filed by Brevard County School District and a Form 500 Notification Letter (Ref.#6)

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dated May 29, 2002 was received by Universal Cabling Systems, Inc. from the SLD granting the request for the contract extension date of 12/31/2002.

On October 21, 2002, after completion of testing and documentation, Universal Cabling Systems submitted to the SLD a 474 Form (Ref.#7) for a draw in the amount of \$78,652.70. On November 11, 2002, a Service Certification form (ref#8) was faxed to Brevard County Schools for an authorization signature and was returned by fax to Universal Cabling signed on 11/11/02.

On December 16, 2002, Brevard County School District received a phone call from Universal Cabling Systems to make us aware that the draw in the amount of \$78,652.70 had been denied. Mr. Anthony Samuels at the SLD gave this information to Universal Cabling verbally over the phone. The reason stated for the denial was that a service extension request had not been filed. Universal Cabling Systems received a confirmation of denial notice dated 12/24/02 (Ref.#9). E-mail was received from Universal Cabling Systems with contact information for Mr. Samuel Adams at the SLD. (Ref.#10)

On December 16, 2002 Brevard County School District contacted Mr. Claude Shipley, Director of the Florida Department of Education E-Rate Program seeking advice regarding the draw denial and the Service Extension Request.

Brevard County was advised by the the Director of the Florida Department of Education E-Rate Program that a Service Extension Request was the responsibility of the vendor to submit, and was given the name and phone number of Keith English, an Invoicing specialist at the SLD to contact for assistance. Brevard County School District immediately contacted Keith for guidance. Mr. English verbally over the phone confirmed to Brevard County School District that the vendor customarily submits a Service Extension Request, but in this case, to expedite the release of the funds, Brevard County School District could submit this request for Universal Cabling. Keith English assisted with the verbiage that needed to be contained in the Service Extension Request letter. It was promptly submitted on December 17, 2002 to the SLD via certified mail (Ref. #11) and electronically submitted to the email address given by Mr. English; [SLDCorrespondenceunit@sl.universalservice.org](mailto:SLDCorrespondenceunit@sl.universalservice.org) (Ref.#12). A confirmation e-mail receipt was sent to Brevard County Schools from the SLD (Ref.#13). Keith English assured Brevard County Schools that this matter would be resolved quickly, possibly within several weeks.

On January 8, 2003, an inquiry was sent via electronic mail from Brevard County Schools to [SLDCorrespondenceunit@sl.universalservice.org](mailto:SLDCorrespondenceunit@sl.universalservice.org) requesting a status update of the Service Extension request. A return receipt was received from the SLD on 1/8/03 (Ref.#14)

On January 17, 2003 another inquiry was sent by Brevard County School District to the SLD via [SLDCorrespondenceunit@sl.universalservice.org](mailto:SLDCorrespondenceunit@sl.universalservice.org) and a return receipt/reply was received from the SLD.(Ref.#15).

On February 2, 2003, Brevard County School District received a letter from the Schools & Libraries Division addressing the Service Extension Request. This letter was simply a

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notification that all correspondences had been received and was in the process of being reviewed. (Ref.#16)

On February 18, 2002 after receiving no further correspondence from the SLD Brevard County School District contacted the Director of the Florida Department of Education E-rate Program, Claude Shipley, for assistance to elevate the urgency of this matter with the SLD.

Brevard County School District believes that no intentional errors were made with this FRN. Noted below are several inconsistencies with the SLD guidance:

- The Schools & Libraries website does not indicate anywhere on the Applicants Forms web page, Applicants Step-By-Step web page or Schools & Libraries Site Map (Ref. #17) any additional documents required to extend a contract for service other than the Form 500, which Brevard County Schools filed on May 8, 2002, within the approved timeframe. Without reference to additional documentation required, it would be impossible for any applicant to be knowledgeable of any such Service Extension Request requirement.
- Form 500 does not indicate that additional documentation is required to extend service through the Contract Extension date.
- No Form 500 Notification Letter was sent to the applicant who filed the Form 500 – the approval of the Contract Extension was mailed to the vendor. **This** is inconsistent with all the other applicant required forms, which require a Receipt of Acknowledgement letter for auditable purposes.
- The applicant is never in a position to contact an invoicing representative at the SLD, this need would only arise for the vendor with billing concerns. The SLD help line (1-888-203-8100) was not even aware of a Service Extension only the Contract Extension and referred the phone call to the Invoicing Department. After speaking to Invoicing, it was only then that the Service Extension was mentioned, and the SLD Invoicing Specialist gave incorrect information to Brevard County School Districts.

We believe that the inconsistencies outlined above; the concerted effort from the applicant staff; doing what is right for the students in the classroom; and providing fairness to small vendor owners, this denial should immediately be reversed and final payment be made to the vendor for service completed and well done.

Thank you for your 2001-2002 E-rate application and for any assistance you provided throughout our review. We have completed review of your Form 471. This letter is to advise you of our decision(s).

FUNDING COMMITMENT REPORT

On the pages following this letter, we have provided a Funding Commitment Report for the Form 471 application cited above. We have reviewed each Discount Funding Request on your Form 471 application and have assigned a Funding Request Number (FRN) to each Block 5. The enclosed report includes a list of the FRNs from your application. The SLD is also sending this information to your service provider(s) so preparations can be made to begin implementing your E-rate discount(s) upon the filing of your Form 486. Immediately preceding the Funding Commitment Report, you will find a guide that defines each line of the Report.

NEXT STEPS

Once you have reviewed this letter and have determined that some or all of your requests have been funded, your next step to facilitate receipt of discounts as featured in this letter will be to file an FCC Form 486 with the SLD. The Form 486 notifies the SLD to begin payment to your service provider and provides certified indication that your technology plan(s) has been approved. The Form 486 and instructions can be found on the SLD web site at <[www.sl.universalservice.org](http://www.sl.universalservice.org)> or you can call the SLD Client Service Bureau at 1-888-203-8100 and ask that the form be sent to you. The new Form 486, dated July 2001 in the lower right corner, MUST be used for Funding Year 4 and for any previous funding years once it becomes available. Subsequent submissions of earlier versions of the Form 486 will be returned to you and will not be able to be processed. As you complete Form 486, you should also contact your service provider to verify they have received notice from the SLD of your funding commitments. After the SLD processes your Form 486, we can begin processing invoices from your service provider(s) so they can be reimbursed for discounted services they have provided you.

On December 21, 2000, the Children's Internet Protection Act was signed into law. That law will require schools and libraries that receive Universal Service discounts for certain services to adopt an Internet safety policy incorporating the use of filtering or blocking technology on computers with Internet access as a condition of receiving those discounts. THE LAW DOES NOT, HOWEVER, REQUIRE THIS TO BE IN PLACE FOR FUNDING YEAR 4. If Funding Year 4 services start on or before Sunday, October 28, 2001 and the date of your Funding **Commitment** Decision Letter is before Sunday, October 26, 2001, your Form 486 must be postmarked on or before October 28, 2001 in order for discounts to be paid retroactively to the Service Start Date. Failure to meet this certification deadline will result in reduced funding.
2. If your services start after October 28 2001, your Form 486 must be postmarked no later than 120 days after the Service Start Date or 120 days after the date of the Funding **Commitment** Decision Letter, whichever is later, in order for discounts to be paid retroactively to the Service Start Date. Failure to meet this filing deadline will result in reduced funding.

#### NOTICE ON RULES AND FUNDS AVAILABILITY

Applicants' receipt of funding commitments is contingent on their compliance with all statutory, regulatory, and procedural requirements of the universal service mechanisms for schools and libraries. FCC Form 471 Applicants who have received funding commitments continue to be subject to audits and other reviews that SLD or the Federal Communications Commission may undertake periodically to assure that funds have been committed and are being used in accordance with all such requirements. If the SLD subsequently determines that its commitment was erroneously issued due to action or inaction, including but not limited to that by SLD, the Applicant, or Service Provider, and that the action or inaction was not in accordance with such requirements, SLD may be required to cancel these funding commitments and seek repayment of any funds disbursed not in accordance

A GUIDE TO THE FUNDING COMMITMENT REPORT

Attached to this letter will be a report for each E-rate funding request from your application. We are providing the following definitions.

**FUNDING REQUEST NUMBER (FRN):** A Funding Request Number is assigned by the SLD to each Block 5 of your Form 471 once an application has been processed. This number is used to report to Applicants and Service Providers the status of individual discount funding requests submitted on a Form 471.

**FUNDING STATUS:** Each FRN will have one of three definitions: "Funded," "Not Funded," or "As Yet Unfunded."

1. An FRN that is "Funded" will be approved at the level that SLD determined is appropriate for that item. The funding level will generally be the level requested unless the SLD determines during the application review process that some adjustment is appropriate.
2. An FRN that is "Not Funded" is one for which no funds will be committed. The reason for the decision will be briefly explained in the "Funding Commitment Decision," and amplification of that explanation may be offered in the section, "Funding Commitment Decision Explanation." An FRN may be "Not Funded" because the request does not comply with program rules, or because the total amount of funds in the Universal Service Fund was insufficient to fund all requests.
3. An FRN that is "As Yet Unfunded" reflects a temporary status that is assigned to an FRN when the SLD is uncertain at the time the letter is generated whether there will be sufficient funds to make commitments for requests for internal connections at a particular discount level. For example, if your application included requests for discounts on both telecommunications services and internal connections, you might receive a letter with our funding commitment for your telecommunications funding requests and a message that four internal connections requests are "As Yet Unfunded." You would receive a subsequent letter(s) regarding the funding decision on your internal connections requests.

**SERVICES ORDERED:** The type of service ordered from the service provider, as shown on Form 471.

**SPIN (Service Provider Identification Number):** A unique number assigned by the Universal Service Administrative Company to service providers seeking payment from the Universal Service Fund for participation in the universal service support programs. A SPIN is also used to verify delivery of services and to arrange for payment.

**SERVICE PROVIDER NAME:** The legal name of the service provider.

**CONTRACT NUMBER:** The number of the contract between the eligible party and the service provider. This will be present only if a contract number was provided on Form 471.

**BILLING ACCOUNT NUMBER:** The account number that your service provider has established with you for billing purposes. This will be present only if a Billing Account Number was provided on Form 471.

**EARLIEST POSSIBLE EFFECTIVE DATE OF DISCOUNT:** The first possible date of service for which the SLD will reimburse service providers for the discounts for the service.

**CONTRACT EXPIRATION DATE:** The date the contract expires. This will be present only if a contract expiration date was provided on Form 471.

**SITE IDENTIFIER:** The Entity Number listed in Form 471, Block 5, Item 22a will be listed. This will appear only for "site specific" FRNs.

**PRE-DISCOUNT AMOUNT:** Amount in Form 471, Block 5, Item 23, Column I, as determined through the application review process.

**DISCOUNT PERCENTAGE APPROVED BY THE SLD:** This is the discount rate that the SLD has approved for this service.

**FUNDING COMMITMENT DECISION:** This represents the total amount of funding that the SLD has reserved to reimburse service providers for the approved discounts for this service through June 30, 2002. It is important that you and the service provider both recognize that the SLD should be invoiced and the SLD may direct disbursement of discounts only for eligible, approved services actually rendered.

Dear Ms. Fadok:

I strongly support this compelling appeal submitted by Brevard County School District to ensure payment of the Universal Cabling Company. They have not done anything wrong according to the School and Library Division (SLD) process, yet could be negatively impacted upon by lack of payment for work provided to the school district i.e. go out of business.

My concern and very strong support for what I believe is a compelling case, is predicated upon the confusion caused by the lack of single source documentation for **an** applicant to know that they have to submit both the Contract Extension and the Service Provider Extension. The confusion of the district staff as to the correct procedures **after** communications with SLD also exacerbated the problem. In addition, it was not until the end of February 2003, that SLD said they were not authorized to provide an extension if the request was made after September 30, 2002.

Conversations with SLD were initiated in December 2002, and the processing time of going directly to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) could have started then and not in March 2003. This time delay negatively **impacts** upon the business Universal Cabling, that **has** indicated to me in e-mail (also provided to SLD) and telephone conversations that they might go out of business due to the lack of payment.

The lack of payment, **as** we now understand it is, of no fault of the service provider. However, in my opinion it is due to the lack of clearly defined guidance in one location on the SLD website or by SLD personnel for submitting both extensions by the applicant.

Lon Fadok initially presented me with the payment of the contractor problem in December **2002**. I called **PIA** about the proper methodology for a Service Provider extension. As **this** was not their area of expertise, it was suggested that I call Keith at Invoicing. Keith explained to me that the Service Provider extension **was** the responsibility of the service provider. As I wished to ensure that Lon Fadok clearly understood the process, I had her call Keith. He confirmed the same information that he had provided to me and explained the process of submitting a Service Provider Extension.

Lori Fadok decided to expedite the process and submit the Service Provider extension on her own rather than work it out with the service provider. Keith said ~~that~~ was perfectly acceptable; either could do it. The request was denied due to the deadline of September **30, 2002** had been missed. School and Library Division was not allowed **per** the FCC to provide **an** extension request submitted after September **30, 2002**.

Thank you for your assistance and once again, I strongly urge granting Brevard County School District's appeal.
