**NOTIFICATION PERTAINING TO PETITION FOR LIMITED WAIVER OF
SECTION 20.18(C) OF THE COMMISSION'S RULES**

SLO Cellular, Inc. d/b/a Cellular One of San Luis Obispo and its commonly controlled affiliate, Entertainment Unlimited, Inc. (collectively "the Petitioners"), pursuant to Sections 1.3 and 1.925 of the Commission's Rules, hereby notify the Commission that the system modifications needed to permit the Petitioners to process 911 calls from digital wireless Text Telephone ("TTY") devices were completed on March 28, 2003.

In their joint "Petition for Limited Waiver of Section 20.18(c) of the Commission's Rules" ("Petition"), filed June 28, 2002 as amended on December 24, 2002, the Petitioners requested until March 31, 2003 to comply with the Rule Section 20.18(c) requirements for operators of digital wireless systems to be capable of

transmitting 911 calls from speech or hearing impaired individuals through the use of TTY devices.

As noted above, the system modifications required to render the systems digital wireless TTY compliant were completed on March 28, 2003. Thus, the Petition is now moot on a going forward basis.
