

I believe you need to investigate bluemountain.com It is an e-card greeting service. I am semi-convinced that their "address book" feature is sending addresses to virused cites.

They last year started charging a fee for their service and also installed an ADDRESS BOOK feature as an add-in to that fee. When you send a card, the email address you send to is AUTOMATICALLY added to their address book on our computers. I have been in contact with them and have been notified by their customer service agents that you CANNOT delete or disable this feature. Please check them out.
