("Cumulus"), licensee of Station KMAJ(FM), Topeka, Kansas, by its counsel, hereby submits its Comments to the Notice of Proposed Rule Making ("NPRM") in the above-captioned proceeding, DA 03-192, released January 31, 2003. In response to the petition, the NPRM proposes to change the community of allotment and downgrade the license for Channel 299C at Topeka, Kansas, to Channel 299C1 at Shawnee, Kansas. This proposed change of community would provide Shawnee with a first local aural transmission service.




