This is to notify you that on March 20, 2003, Ralph Justus, Vice President, the Consumer Electronics Association (CEA); John Godfrey of Sony Electronics, Inc.; Adam Goldberg of Sharp Laboratories of America, Inc.; and the undersigned met with David Moulton, Chief of Staff, Congressman Ed Markey; Lori Holy, FCC Office of Legislative Affairs; and Alan Stillwell, Associate Chief (Policy), OET.

During this meeting the participants discussed issues addressed in the above-referenced proceeding related to the Program System and Information Protocol (PSIP) standard and v-chip functionality. Specifically, operation of the ATSCA/65A PSIP standard and v-chip functionality in digital television receivers was discussed, including information on related standards EIA-766 and EIA-608-B; the blocking functionality provided by the v-chip; and operation of the Rating Region Table (RRT).
