**Quarterly Report of Farmers Mutual Telephone Company
Regarding TTY Access to Digital Wireless Systems**

Farmers Mutual Telephone Company (“Farmers”) hereby reports on its implementation of text telephone (“TTY”) access to digital wireless systems, in compliance with the Federal Communications Commission’s (“FCC” or “Commission”) *Waiver Grant Order* in the above-captioned proceeding.¹

Farmers is now capable of transmitting 911 calls from individuals with speech or hearing disabilities through the use of TTY devices in accordance with the Commission’s Rules.² Accordingly, pursuant to the *Waiver Grant Order*,³ this is the final quarterly report on TTY access that will be filed by Farmers.
