Today, Kevin Morefield, Thomas J. Noto, and Adam Bass from the Ameriquest Mortgage Company ("Ameriquest") together with Ian D. Volner and Ronald M. Jacobs of Venable, and Clayton S. Friedman of Baker & McKenzie discussed the Commission's rules implementing the Telephone Consumer Protection Act of 1991 ("TCPA") in three (3) separate meetings with:

- 1.) Lisa Zaina, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Adelstein;
