

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter and its confidential attachment are being provided by Qwest Communications International Inc. ("Qwest") at the request of the FCC Staff. In an April 4, 2003 letter, Qwest notified the FCC that there are at least 278 CLEC provided UNE-P residential lines in service in New Mexico as of March 31, 2003, based on residential white pages directory listings associated with UNE-P lines in service.<sup>1</sup> In response to the FCC Staff's request, Qwest is providing a confidential attachment that contains a CLEC-specific breakdown of the 278 UNE-P residential listings.

The twenty-page limit does *not* apply to this submission
