DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 252A to Silverton, Texas, as that community's first local broadcast transmission service. Silverton, Texas is an incorporated community of 764 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. Silverton is also the county seat of Briscoe County. Silverton has its own mayor, its own post office, its own fire department, its own school district, its own city hall and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 252A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Silverton residents and therefore is in the public interest.


