COMMENTS IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSED RULE MAKING

These comments are filed on behalf of Capital Community Broadcasting, Inc. ("CCB"), licensee of noncommercial educational Station KTOO-TV, NTSC Channel *3, Juneau, Alaska and permittee of companion Station KTOO-DT, Channel *6. CCB is the proponent of the proposal set forth in the above-captioned Notice of Proposed Rule Making to substitute DTV Channel *10 for its assigned DTV Channel *6.

CCB hereby supports the expeditious adoption of the proposal. For the reasons set forth in the Petition, which are summarized in the Notice and which are hereby incorporated by reference, the DTV Table of Allotments should be amended as proposed. In brief, the proposed amendment substituting a VHF high-band channel for a low-band one would facilitate reception by area viewers of both local DTV stations using more efficient and compact receiving antennas. CCB will promptly apply for DTV Channel *10 when it is allotted and, when authorized, will promptly build its DTV station using that channel within the time limits specified by the Commission.

In view of this showing, the DTV channel substitution should be made as proposed.
